Hellertown Soldier Second Time In C

Sgt. Paul A. Lippert, son of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Lippert, 1059 Third Avenue, Hellertown, has been wounded a second time while serving with an infantry regiment in Germany, according to a telegram received yesterday from the War Department. The soldier is now in a hospital somewhere on the continent. He was wounded last November 25.

Sgt. Lippert previously was wounded July 26 and after a long hospitalization recently returned to duty. Prior to his induction he was engaged as a machinist with the Bethlehem Steel Company. He entered the service November 7, 1943, and trained in Alabama, Tennessee and Arizona.
