**Lieut. Gordon Ruhf
Back In U. S. After
Mission Abroad FEB 23 1944**

MIAMI BEACH — Second Lieut. Gordon M. Ruhf of Tatamy, recently returned from service outside the continental United States, now is being processed through the Army Air Forces Redistribution Station No. 2 in Miami Beach, where his next assignment will be recommended.

Lieutenant Ruhf, age 26, is the husband of Mrs. Virginia A. Ruhf of Broad Street, Tatamy. He is a son of Mrs. Naomi Ruhf of Center Street, Stockertown. He attended Nazareth High School and entered the Army in March, 1942. As a B-24 bombardier, he flew six missions in China; shot down near enemy lines and spent 17 days returning to his base. He was awarded the Purple Heart.
