Pfc. Lloyd Stern was reported seriously wounded on Leyte Island November 24, 1944, in a War Department telegram received by his mother, Mrs. Mary Stern, 320 Sheffield Street. Pfc. Stern entered the service May 8, 1942, and received his basic training at Camp Wheeler, Ga., and at San Francisco, Calif., before going overseas two years ago. He is attached to an engineer branch of the infantry. Since entering the service, Pfc. Stern has never received a furlough. His brother, Corporal Morris Stern, is serving somewhere in France. Another brother, Paul Stern, was honorably discharged from the Navy in September of last year. Four nephews are serving with the U. S. Army and one with the U. S. Navy.
