LT. J. H. REIDY TO WED MISS BARBARA TENNANT

**Engagement to Chicago Young
Woman Announced—Wed-
ding in Fall.**

Enroute from one post to another Lieut. J. Hamil Reidy, formerly of Bethlehem, stopped off in Chicago, Ill., long enough, the Chicago Daily News stated last week, for his engagement to Miss Barbara Tennant to be announced at a suprise party at her home in Highland Park. Miss Tennant is the daughter of Mrs. J. Lufkin Tennant of Highland Park.

She is a graduate of Roycemore School in Evanston and of Finch Junior College in New York. She is active in the Chicago branch of the Junior League.

Lieut. Reidy is a son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Thomas Reidy, of Bethlehem, and was graduated from Lehigh University in 1935.

While in college he was a sprinter on the track team, having hung up a number of records and also a member of the varsity football team.

Following his graduation he took the loop course at the Bethlehem Steel Company and was assigned to the sales department in the Chicago office.

Following the announcement at the supper party Lieut. Reidy left for Corpus Christi, Tex., where he will attend the Naval Aid Corps school for three months.

One of the first of the aviation volunteer specialists from Chicago to train at Quonset, R. I., he has been stationed more recently at Norfolk, Va.

He and Miss Tennant plan to be married in Fall when he has completed his course.
