Sgt. Connors Now Prisoner In Nazi Camp

A message, printed in German, received yesterday by Mr. and Mrs. John Connors of 455 South New Street, informed them that their son, Sergeant Francis Connors, reported missing since last October, is a German prisoner.

The note reads: "I am well in

a German prison camp. I will be taken in the next few days to another place which I shall describe in my next letter. I am permitted to receive letters from you and also permitted to write letters to you. Hearty greetings."

He enlisted in the armed forces on June 13, 1942, received his preliminary training at Camp Pickett, Va., and Camp Blanding, Fla., and was sent overseas on April 15 of last year. He attended Liberty High School.

A brother, Staff Sergeant James Connors, U. S. Marine Corps, was reported missing in action, "somewhere in the Philippine area," more than six weeks ago.
