Eisenhart is attached to the Air Photo Unit of Task Group 15 which will accomplish all AAF photography of the atomic bomb test. His unit is equipped with the very latest photographic equipment including high speed cameras, Hollywood motion picture cameras and standard aerial cameras to record scientific data.
