**Sgt. Randall Home  
After 18 Mos. Abroad**

After 19 months in the American Middle East theater of war as a member of the Air Transport Command, Sgt. William B. Randall returned home last evening.

This is Sgt. Randall's first furlough since June 12, 1942, when he enlisted in the service. A graduate of Moravian Preparatory School and Moravian College for Men, he is a son of Mr. and Mrs. H. David Randall of the Bath Pike. He received his basic training at Keesler Field, Miss., continuing courses in radio operation at Marison, Wis., and Kearns, Utah, before being sent overseas.
