Mr. and Mrs. Alex Madryga received a War Department telegram yesterday informing them that their son, Michael Madryga, died in Germany, April 18, 1945.

Overseas since February 12, 1945, the young soldier completed his training at Camp Swift, Texas; Louisiana and California. He served as a chief messenger in a communication center. He is a graduate of Bethlehem Technical High School and a former employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company. While in school, he was a member of the Hi-Y Club. Twenty-one years of age, he was also a member of the St. Josephat's Greek Catholic Church. He is survived by his parents and a sister, Goldie.
