## Hurt In Action

Mrs. Elizabeth Sandoe, 49 West Spruce Street, was informed by the War Department, that her son, Pvt. George B. Sandoe, was seriously wounded on Okinawa, April 11, 1945. Pvt. Sandoe enlisted in November, 1943, and completed his training at Camp White, Oregon, before going overseas in June, 1944. He holds the Expert Infantry Badge awarded to him for "meritorious service." A veteran of many Philippine engagements, he is recuperating in a General Hospital at present. He is a Bethlehem Technical High School graduate and a former Globe-Times carrier. He is also a member of the American Legion Post 406, Fountain Hill, Veterans of Foreign Wars and of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church.
