Clifford Trauger, a member of a medical detachment, was awarded the Bronze Star and a citation for meritorious service in connection with military service against the enemy in the vicinity of Ormoc, Leyte, P. I., December 13, 1944. Trauger, now Private First Class, has been serving overseas in the New Caledonia, Guam and Leyte campaigns since May, 1944. The citation accompanying the award read in part, "His actions have been an inspiration to all the members of his unit, and were instrumental in saving the lives of several of his comrades."

Pfc. Trauger is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Linford Trauger, 24 Saucon Street, Hellertown. He entered the service in October, 1943, and after completing his training at Camp Grant, Ill., was sent overseas. He is a former employe of the Bush and Bull Corporation and of the Bethlehem Steel Company. Trauger is also a Bethlehem High School graduate.
