

Kilcullen, Thomas J.

Given Citation



The Silver Star Medal was awarded Sgt. Thomas J. Kilcullen, son of Alderman and Mrs. John Kilcullen, 515 Carlton Avenue, and a citation for "gallantry in action July 30, 1944, in France."

The seasoned fighter is with the 2nd Armored Division—the Division whose activities were kept secret until its spectacular stand during the African campaign November 8, 1942. From here, Sgt. Kilcullen went on to French Morocco and Sicily. On June 6 he arrived in France and since then he has swept through Belgium, Holland, and now the German border, with his 78th Armored Field Division Battalion.

Inducted July 25, 1941, he received his training at Fort Bragg, N. C., and Fort Benning, Ga. Kilcullen attended Bethlehem Catholic High school and was employed by the Traffic Department of the Lehigh Valley Railroad, New York City.
