TRAIN AT SAN ANTONIO

SAN ANTONIO AVIATION CADET CENTER, Texas, Oct. 22—Among cadets now stationed at the Army Air Forces Pre-Flight School for Pilots at the San Antonio Aviation Cadet Center, the nation's largest pool for fighting air crews, are 434 young men from Pennsylvania. When they have completed their studies and training at the pre-flight school, the cadets will be sent to a primary flying field. Still further training in basic and advanced flying schools will prepare them to be combat pilots.
