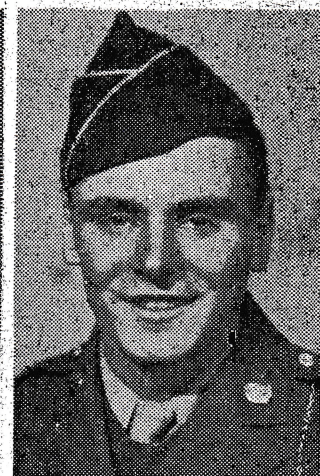

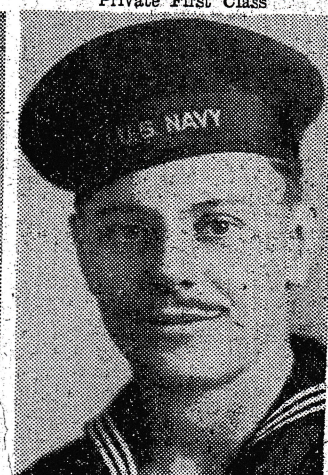

Miller Heights Brothers In Navy, Army And Seabees

Six service stars hang in the windows of 222 Third Street, Miller Heights, the home of Mr. and Mrs. Raymond Schoenberger, who are the proud parents of six sons in the armed forces. Three are in the U. S. Army, two in the Navy and one in the Seabees. Mrs. Schoenberger, formerly of Freemansburg, writes to each of her sons once a week and the mail man, to her, is one of the most important personages these days as she eagerly awaits news from her boys. Mr. Schoenberger is a structural steelworker.

Pfc. Carl Schoenberger was the first of the sons to enter the service, August 20, 1942. He received his basic training at Portland, Oregon, and later was transferred to Seattle, Wash. At the present time he is stationed in Alaska. He has not been home on furlough since his enlistment. He was formerly employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company.

Pfc. Harvey Schoenberger entered the service in December, 1942, and received his basic training at Camp Haan, California and was transferred from there to Fort Custer, Mich. At the present time he is stationed with the M. P. E. G. at Camp Greeley, Colorado. He was formerly employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company.

Pfc. Paul Schoenberger was inducted September 14, 1943, received his basic training at Fort McClellan, Ala., and is now stationed at San Francisco, California.

Ellsworth H. Schoenberger, M. M. 3-c., inducted in the Seabees October 29, 1943, received his boot training at Camp Peary, Virginia, and advanced training at Camp Thomas, Rhode Island. At the present time he is stationed with the 130th Naval Construction Battalion in the Hawaiian Islands. He is married to the former Miss Helen Klepper, of Hellertown. He was formerly employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company.

Howard Schoenberger, Seaman 2-c., was inducted in the Navy March 10, 1944, and is the youngest of the sons in the service. He is stationed at the Naval Base, Bainbridge, Md.

C. LeRoy Schoenberger, Seaman 2-c., was inducted in the Navy, June 7, 1943, and received his boot training at Sampson, N. Y. He attended torpedo school and will be on submarine duty. At the present time he is stationed at New London, Connecticut. He is married to the former Miss Polly Paukovich, of Stockertown, and was home recently visiting his wife and daughter Nina.
