Brought To U. S.
For Hospitalization**

Corp. Isaac High of Quakertown Friday returned to this country from Italy. He was wounded in action, received the Purple Heart and was hospitalized in Italy. He is now in a hospital on Long Island, N. Y.

His bravery in single handedly attacking a German ammunition dump and pill box was the subject of a story carried by the Associated Press during the past summer. His Pennsylvania Dutch dialect was used by him in communicating with the Germans, forcing them to surrender. His wife, the former Edna Schueck, resides in the Fretz Apartments on East Broad Street.
