

Nemesh, Alexander

Arrives in States

Alexander Nemesh, 27, chief signalman, USN, 1740 Main St., Hometown, has just arrived in the United States aboard the 1,000-ton minesweeper USS Sentry. The ship was expected to reach San Diego, Cal., Monday.

The Sentry completed numerous sweeping operations during and following the war, the most important being in the Philippine and Borneo areas and the recent clearing of the Korean Straits. While based at Sasebo for another job, the squadron to which the Sentry was attached, rode out two typhoons—cutting mines, then ducking to safety until the seas calmed.
