Word was received by Mr. and Mrs. Albert J. Lakey, Bath R. 2, (Chapman Quarries) that their son, Pfc. John A. Lakey, is a prisoner of war of the German government. The telegram, sent from the government at Washington D. C., stated that the word was received through the International Red Cross, and that a letter of information will follow.

Lakey, 22 years old, served with the 80th Reconnaissance Troop. He entered the service October 5, 1942, and went overseas July 15, 1944. He was reported missing in action on August 31 in France. Another brother, Wilfred, Storekeeper 3c, U. S. Navy, is serving in Trinidad.
