partment by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Peter Nichols, of 733 Pen Argyl Street, Pen Argyl.

One of four sons of Mr. and Mrs. Nichols to see service in the U. S. Armed Forces, he enlisted in the Air Force on January 5, 1941. Prior to entering the service he was employed by the Florot Trucking Service.

He has two brothers who are now in service, while a third brother has been given an honorable discharge from the Army.
