Cooke, 924 West Broad Street, by command of Major General Harris, has been commended for superior ability he has displayed as an artist at the Ordnance School, Aberdeen Proving Grounds, Md. The commendation read in part: "The effort and initiative described, reflects the highest degree of credit upon S/Sgt. Cooke and the Ordnance School. With a very limited time and a minimum of first hand information at their disposal, they displayed superior ability, judgment and initiative."
