Three Bethlehem soldiers who saw action in the Sicilian drive and were wounded during the battles which preceded the fall of the Italian isle, are patients in the Valley Forge Military Hospital, Valley Forge, Pa., it was learned Sunday when members of V. F. W. Post No. 855, Bethlehem, visited the institution and took 25 radios for the men.
