**Safe On Guadalcanal**

Word was received during the weekend of the safety of Pfc. Joseph Gyorek, son of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Gyorek, 501 Sioux Street, after several months with the U. S. Marines on embattled Guadalcanal.

Pfc. Gyorek, who enlisted in the Marine Corps nearly two years ago, is now resting with others of the valiant fighters who withstood the Japanese onslaughts for several months before being relieved recently.

The letter, dated February 1, simply said he was safe and enjoying himself. It did not state where the Marines were resting or how long they would be there, or whether he would get home on furlough.

Pfc. Gyorek is a former member of the Bethlehem Boys Club and at present a member of the Boys Club Fraternity.
