S/Sgt. Herbert O. Muschlitz, battalion supply sergeant with a veteran aviation engineer unit in Italy, has seen 30 consecutive months active duty in North Africa, Sicily, Italy and Southern France, in addition to Greenland, Newfoundland and Iceland, since donning the olive drab 14 years ago.

The highly decorated sergeant holds a letter of recommendation for duty rendered by him when he braved climatic conditions in the freezing cold to aid an English Army convoy that had been in distress, seven battle participation stars, the Good Conduct Medal, American Defense Medal, and the European-North African and Middle Eastern service ribbons.

Sgt. Muschlitz's four married sisters are Mrs. Grace Lazarus, Mrs. Eva Belgrasch, Mrs. Ruth Zeitner, all of this city, and Mrs. Florence Dickert, Freemansburg.
