Pvt. Joseph J. Fabian, 1021 East Fourth Street and Pfc. Joseph T. Eassararil, 743 Second Street, are fighting along the Arno River in Italy with the 133rd Infantry Regiment that has been a nightmare to battered German troops throughout the Fifth Army's Italian campaign.

With a record of having taken every objective assigned to it, the 133rd has become one of the most decorated units in the Mediterranean Theater. Scattered among the fighting infantrymen of the unit are two Congressional Medals of Honor, 10 Distinguished Service Crosses, 117 Silver Stars for gallantry in action and more than 1500 Purple Heart awards.
