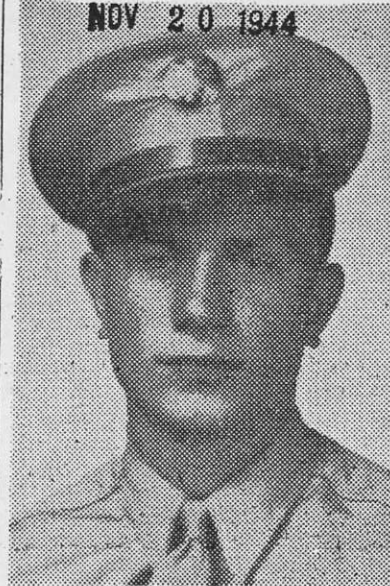


Gawlik, Adam T.

Nazi Prisoner

Staff Sergeant Adam T. Gawlik, U. S. Air Corps, son of Mr. and Mrs. John Gawlik, of 1312 East Sixth Street, is a prisoner of Germany, since September 18, according to information received from the War Department by the parents.

A graduate of Liberty High School, the 22-year-old Bethlehemite was inducted into the combat forces on February 6, 1943, received his wings as an aerial gunner at Fort Meyers, Fla., and graduated from a radio school at Sioux Falls, S. D. Before his induction he was an employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company.

He has been overseas for about a year and was on his 34th mission over enemy territory when taken prisoner.
