A Climate Action Plan (CAP) addresses climate change by promoting resilience through mitigation strategies that reduce greenhouse gas emissions such as increased energy efficiency, and through adaptation strategies that help the community prepare for the impacts of climate change such as stormwater runoff improvements for flood prevention.

The City and consultant WSP will present draft climate action strategies for a range of sectors, from buildings to transportation to education, with a focus on environmental justice considerations.

Then we will seek input from City residents on ideas and priorities for strategies.
