## Lieut. (jg) Gordon M. Moyer Reported Missing In Action

**MAR 28, 1945**

Lieutenant (j. g.) Gordon M. Moyer, 21, navigator for the U. S. Army Air Corps, is missing in action in Germany since March 13, according to a telegram received from the War Department yesterday afternoon by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Eden F. Moyer, 610 South Hoffert Street, Fountain Hill.

The last letter written by him to his parents was dated March 8 and received March 19.

Lt. Moyer made his first mission over Germany territory on March 12 and the second the following

day on which he was reported missing. He reached overseas on March 1, 1945.

He entered the service on Jan. 20, 1943, while a freshman at Lehigh University, which he entered after graduating from Fountain Hill High School in 1941.

He graduated from the navigator school at Monroe, La., and sent overseas last March 1. On May 8, would have been his 22nd birthday.
