Mrs. Raymond Fritz, 429 Chestnut Street, Emmaus, received a telegram from the War Department stating that her husband Pvt. Raymond Fritz, had been killed in action in Italy, September 27.

He attended Washington Junior and Technical High Schools. Before entering the service, he was employed by the Allentown Air Reduction. He took basic training at Fort Knox, Ky., and was transferred to Fort Meade, Md., before being sent overseas.

Pvt. Fritz is survived by his wife, the former Dorothy Dankel, a 2½-year-old daughter, Barbara; four sisters, Dorothy, of Emmaus; Mrs. Weldon Cressman, Fountain Hill; Mrs. J. Zadiavec, Hellertown; and Mrs. Paul Kleckner, Bethlehem; two brothers, John, of Emmaus, and Pfc. Harry, recently returned from the South Pacific.
