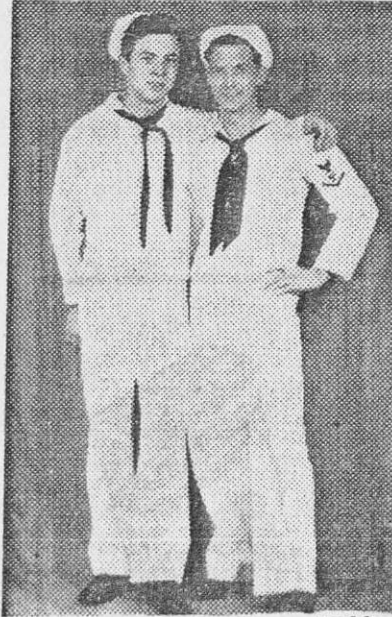


Kohl, James E.
