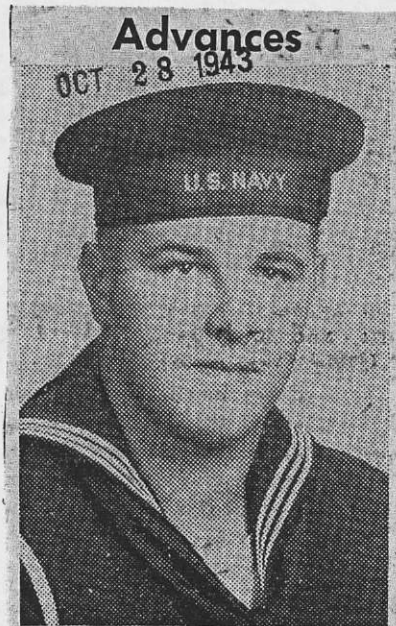


Kauffman, Albert H.



Albert H. Kauffman Jr., who has completed his "boot" training at Sampson, N. Y., has been promoted to the rank of seaman first class. He received the promotion after his return recently to Sampson following a seven-day leave. He visited his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Albert H. Kauffman Sr., 315 West Fourth Street. Two days later he was sent to Purdue University, West Lafayette, Ind., for further training. Seaman Kauffman attended Broughal Junior High School and three years ago began to assist his father in the electrical business.
