Now Flight Officer**

Lieutenant (j.g.) C. G. Feist, USNR, 1321 Montrose Avenue, recently returned from a tour of duty as pilot of a Navy torpedo plane based on a baby flattop, has returned to Seattle, Wash., after completing a 33-day leave.

According to a letter received by his father, George W. Feist, he has been made flight officer of his squadron and expects to return to active duty within the next few months.

Lieut. Feist, attached to Composite Squadron 68, flew an Avenger which can attack with bombs, rockets or .50-calibre machine gun fire as well as with torpedoes.
