## Purple Heart



Mr. and Mrs. Floyd W. Strohl, 129 West Fairview St., received the Purple Heart awarded to their son, Pvt. First Class George W. Strohl, for wounds received in action in France.

Pfc. Strohl was inducted into the Army in July, 1943, and received his basic training at Camp Grant, Ill. He later transferred to the A. S. T. P. and was sent to the University of Oklahoma. Upon completing his course there, he was sent to Camp Howe, Texas, for Infantry training and then overseas in September, 1944.

Now convalescing in a General Hospital in England, he expects to see more action with his 103rd Infantry Division soon. Pfc. Strohl was with the Seventh Army in France when he received his wounds.
