## Stephen Sever War Casualty On Luzon Isle

Sergeant Stephen J. Sever, 25 years old, son of Mr. and Mrs. Mark Sever, 517 East Morton Street, has made the supreme sacrifice. According to a war department telegram received yesterday by his parents, he was killed while in action on Luzon, on March 27.

A graduate of Bethlehem Technical High School and a former employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company, he was in the armed forces for 34 months, and had been overseas for the past two years. He was assigned to the 32nd Infantry Division of the Sixth Army.

Besides his parents, he is survived by two brothers, Michael and John, at home; and four sisters, Olga and Helen, at home, and Mrs. Leonard Donchez and Mrs. Joseph Zamadics, Bethlehem. He was a member of St. Joseph's Windish Church.
