Local Doughboy Killed in Hard Fighting On Anzio Beachhead

Mrs. Robert N. Krause, 343 Hanover Street, was in receipt of a telegram yesterday from the Secretary of War telling about the death of her husband, killed in action April 4, in Italy.

Pfc. Krause, husband of the former Miss Theresa Seiler, was born in New Brunswick, N. J., October 17, 1919. He entered the service February 3, 1942, and received his basic training at Camp Wheeler, Ga. He has been serving with the 45th Infantry Division on the Anzio beachhead since February, 1944. Before entering the service he was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company.

He is survived by his mother, Mrs. Anna Krause, of New Brunswick, N. J.; his wife and six-month-old son, Robert Leo Krause.
