Service Emblem to Be Dedicated Sunday—130 Names on Honor Roll.

In honor of the first 100 young men of the parish now serving with the United States armed forces on the land, sea and in the air, the St. John Capistrano's Church at 10:30 a. m. will dedicate a service flag with 100 stars to be permanently displayed in the church.

The parents and the wives of the first 100 young service men will march in procession for the dedication, headed by the Boy Scout Troop 44, Cub Pack 44 and Girl Scout Troop 44 of the parish with their respective leaders in command.

Each of the honored service men will receive a gift from the congregation, a prayer book, rosary, crucifix, and St. Christopher medal that will be handed over to the parent or wife representing him and serving at the same time as sponsor to the service flag.

Rev. Joseph F. Reseterics, pastor, will bless the flag and preach the sermon and Rev. Francis X. Gilly, assistant pastor, will sing the High Mass.

To date there are officially 130 names on the Parish Honor Roll showing 87 with the Army, 30 with the Navy and Coast Guards, 7 in the Marines and 6 in the Air Corps.
