Ex-Navy Man Enters Wharton School

Robert Richard Wagner, one of the twin sons of Mr. and Mrs. Ernest Wagner, 1605 Calypso Avenue, who was honorably discharged from the

U. S. Navy, Sept. 14, has enrolled as a student in the Wharton School, University of Pennsylvania, where he will study business accounting.

Wagner, who held a yeoman 2-c. rating while in the service, donned Navy Blues Sept. 9, 1939, a year

after graduating from Bethlehem High School. Veteran of the Pacific theater, he served at various times aboard the battleship USS Texas, destroyer USS Wharrington, USS Bancroft and the USS Leo.

His twin brother, First Lt. Ernest

Wagner, Jr., is serving with the ordnance department in Germany. He entered the service March 6, 1939.
