Freemansburg Man Out of Service

Returning to his home at 405 Monroe Street, Freemansburg, Andrew Makarchuk Jr., Radioman 2/c, paused at the Bainbridge, Md., Separation Center long enough last week to be handed his honorable discharge. At the time he was credited with 43 points.

In the Navy for 36 months, he served 18 of them overseas where he saw action in the invasions of Tarawa, Kwajalein, Hollandia, New Guinea, Palau and Guam while aboard the USS Virgo. He wears the American and Asiatic-Pacific theatre ribbons.

Before coming to the separation center, Makarchuk was stationed at the Naval Research Laboratory in Washington, D. C.
