Van Keuren Made Education Officer Of GI Schools

Major Edward Van Keuren, 712 Maple Street, was recently made Education Officer of the Mariannas University, a group of G. I. schools throughout the Marianna Islands sponsored by the WPBC Information and Education Section's Army Education Program.

Typical of the schools is the one on Saipan, where Major Van Keuren is serving. It is situated in a group of prefabricated buildings and is located off the main island highway on the road to 39th General Hospital. Care has been taken to find the most qualified men to teach, and according to Major Van Keuren, the texts used are the best in the States and have been selected by leading civilian educators.

Before going overseas, Major Van Keuren was Chief Supervisor of Training at the Chemical Warfare School, Edgewood Arsenal, Md., which teaches chemical warfare to all branches of the Army, Navy and Marine Corps.

News of his recent appointment was carried in the "Target" G. I. newspaper printed on Saipan.
