## Skull Fracture Fatal to Local Man in Hawaii

Frank Anthony Voros, radio operator 2-C, died of a fractured skull in the Navy Hospital, Hawaii, according to a telegram received from the War Department by the parents, Mr. and Mrs. Adam Koltai, 639 Alaska Street.

Mrs. Koltai last heard from her

son June 5, and in that letter he stated about recuperating in the hospital and according to the telegram he died June 20. He enlisted in the navy September 20, 1942, and received his boot training at the naval base, Rhode Island.

Besides his parents he is survived by a brother, August Voros, seaman 1-C, who is stationed somewhere on the British Isles.
