**Cementon Gunner
Killed In Crash
To Be Buried Saturday**

Technical Sergeant Henry Ferrel of Cementon, who was killed in a bomber plane crash near Blythe Army Air Base, Calif., last Thursday on the day that his Northampton fiancée, Antoinette Morrell, received an engagement ring from him, will be buried Saturday in the Allen Union Cemetery, Northampton.

The body is expected to arrive in Allentown Friday morning and be taken to the Schisler funeral home, 2119 Washington Street, Northampton, where the funeral services will be held at 2 p. m. with the Rev. A. S. Deibert officiating, assisted by Rev. Ralph Hartzell.

The radio-operator-gunner was the son of Edmond and the late Lottie A. (Huber) Ferrell. He was 19 years old.
