Named Commander
Of Deshon Hospital**

BUTLER, Pa., (AP)—Lt. Col. Reginald C. Farrow, Chief Surgical Service, has been named the new commanding officer of Deshon General Hospital here.

He succeeds Col Cleon J. Gentzkow, who left Monday to take charge of Valley Forge General Hospital at Pphonenixville, Pa.

Although all soldier patients were evacuated from Deshon April 30, the Army remains in charge here until June 30. Equipment has not yet been removed from the hospital.

Col. Farrow came here in November, 1942, from Walter Reid Hospital, Washington, D. C. A graduate of Brown and Columbia Universities, he is well known as an orthopedic surgeon.
