Winter enlisted Nov. 4th, 1942 and received his basic training with the army air force at Fresno, California. He studied radio communications at Sioux Falls, S. D., attended Montano State University as an aviation cadet, served at Kearns, Utah, Santa Ana, Cal., Las Vegas, Nevada Hondo,

Texas Westover Field, Mass., Chatam Field, Ga., was commissioned a Second Lieut. at Army Air Force School, Hondo, Texas, May 20th. He is serving with the 15th air force in Italy.

Sgt. Allen T. Winter, was inducted April 1943, received his basic training at Camp Campbell, Ky., Sgt. Winter was assigned to a Tank Battalion and went overseas to England in March 1944, and then on to France, where he recently participated in several major engagements. He was graduated from Nazareth High School.

Paul L. Winter, 18, enlisted in the U. S. Navy July 24th of this year. Is completing his basic training at U. S. Naval Training Center, Sampson, N. Y. Was graduated from the Kingston, Pa. High School in June. The father Paul Winter served in World War One in the 327th Tank Battalion under Major General Eisenhower, now Commander-in-Chief of the Allied Forces in Europe. He served in England, France and Germany. The wife is the former Margaret Scheffler, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Wm. I. Scheffler, Bath.
