Pvt. Correll Writes Parents Of Liberation

Mr. and Mrs. Roland Correll of 2122 Glendale Avenue, received a letter from their son, Pvt. Roland J. Correll Jr., stating he was released from Stalag 7-A, German prison camp, on April 29. It was the first word received from him in four months.

Pvt. Correll also informed his parents he is well and expects to be home soon. He had been reported missing September 25, 1944, and was captured in Aachen, Belgium.

The young infantryman entered the service May 7, 1943, and received his basic training at Camp Shelby, Miss. He arrived in England, May 23, 1944, and subsequently fought in France and took part in the battle of St. Lo before his capture.
