Graduated from the Davis-Monthan Field, Tucson, Ariz., to do combat duty with the Army Air Forces, was Corporal Thomas F. Keim, 19-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Rollin R. Keim, 1128 Monocacy Street, who will soon go overseas as an aerial gunner on a B-24 Liberator bomber.

Corporal Keim and his crewmates were first assembled at the Arizona airfield as a bomber crew, and they have trained together both in the air and on the ground to successfully complete the rigid standards required for aerial combat.

He entered the service in October, 1943, and is a graduate of Bethlehem High School.
