Staff Sergeant Michael Kost, who has been fighting with the U. S. Marine Corps for seven years, was wounded March 10, 1945, for the second time, on iwo Jima, Volcano Islands. His parents, Mr. and Mrs. Peter Kost, 1530 East Second Street, were informed of their son's con-dition by Major D. Routh, Washington. S/Sgt. Kost was wounded previously on February 19, 1945, and was sent back to duty with Fifth Marine Divi-sion after hospitalization. A graduate of Broughal Jun-for High School and Bethle-hem Technical High School, he was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company before he en-listed seven years ago. Since go-ing overseas in 1943, Sgt. Kost participated in the battle for Bougainville, Guadalcanal and Tarawa, when he was attached to the Paratroops. After his company disbanded, he was giv-en a 30-day furlough and was sent back to the Pacific, to Iwo Jima with the Fifth Marine Division. At present, he is re-cuperating in a hospital in the Marianas.
