Solana, 446 Martel Street, was reported missing in action somewhere in the South Pacific since December 7, 1944, in a War Department telegram received by his parents. He was inducted in 1943 and completed his boot training at the Great Lakes Naval Training Center, Ill. He was then sent for further training to the University of Illinois, from where he was assigned to see duty in the Atlantic and more recently in the Pacific. S. M. 2-c Solana is a graduate of Bethlehem Technical High School and was employed by the Briggs Airplane Factory, Detroit, Mich. Two brothers are also in the service, Pfc. M. S. Solana, stationed in Ohio, and Lucas Solana, M. M. 2-c, somewhere in the Pacific. A brother-in-law, R. L. Baily, stationed on Angelo's ship, was reported safe.
