ment as a lieutenant, he had been employed as a night clerk in the Bethlehem Post Office.

Major Bertolet was transferred to the Air Corps three days after the Jap attack on Pearl Harbor. Prior to that he had served with the field and coast artillery and was stationed at Indiantown Gap where he served on the staff of Major General Edward Martin as assistant division chemical officer of the 28th Division.
