

Arthur H. Jones, G. M. 1/C, son of Mr. and Mrs. A. Stanley Jones, 830 North New Street, who was severely burned when his destroyer was hit by a Japanese suicide plane May 25 "somewhere in the Pacific," is convalescing in a base hospital on the Hawaiian Islands.

Holder of the Purple Heart and the Congressional Citation, G. M. 1/C Jones is a veteran of the initial invasions of Southern France and Africa. He entered the U. S. Navy in 1942, while employed by Brown and Borhek Company. Upon his return from the European Theater, he was given a leave and was assigned to the Pacific, where he has been serving since after Christmas. Jones is a graduate of Bethlehem High School.
