T/Sgt. Robert E. Muschlitz has been released from a German prisoner of war camp, according to a letter from a chaplain of the Fifth Armored Division.

Sgt. Muschlitz has been serving overseas with Pennsylvania's 29th Infantry Division for the past 19 months. He entered the service April 22, 1941, and completed his training at camps in the Southern States before going overseas to England. He was taken prisoner November 8, 1944, in the Huertgen Forest push.

His wife, the former Marie Burnhardt, 1102 First Avenue, Hellertown, also received a letter from the liberated sergeant telling of his release. His father, Warren Muschlitz, resides in Allentown, and a brother, Cpl. William, is serving in the Pacific.

May 28, 1945
