Former Localite Rescued After Atlantic Crash

Seaman First Class A. O. M. Gerald L. Sacks, U. S. N. R., recently informed his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Martin E. Sacks, of Perkaspie, formerly of this city, that he was rescued from the Atlantic after being forced down while returning from a mission to his base.

He also states that he was injured in the crash of his plane, but is now recovering. He observed his birthday anniversary on October 5 and one year in the service on October 6.

Seaman Sacks received his boot training at Great Lakes Naval Training Station, where he was a member of the famous Great Lakes Choir. On April 15 he graduated from a training school at Memphis, Tenn., and was then transferred to Bermuda, where he is now stationed.
