

Titus, Edward!

Reported Dead

Mrs. Walter Zabower, 330 Northampton Street, Hellertown, received a telegram from the War Department stating that her father, Pfc. Edward T. Titus, reported missing in action as of November 8, 1944, is now reported killed in action as of that same date. In an official message accompanying the telegram, Mrs. Zabower was informed that her father lost his life by drowning in the Rhone River, Lyons, France, while engaged in constructing a gasoline pipeline river crossing. Pfc. Titus was inducted in April, 1942, and took part in the invasions of Africa, Italy and France. In addition to his daughter, he is survived by a grandson, Dennis Allen Zabower; one sister, Mrs. Hiram Purcell of Allentown, and four brothers, William, Harry, Charles and John Titus, all of Bethlehem.
