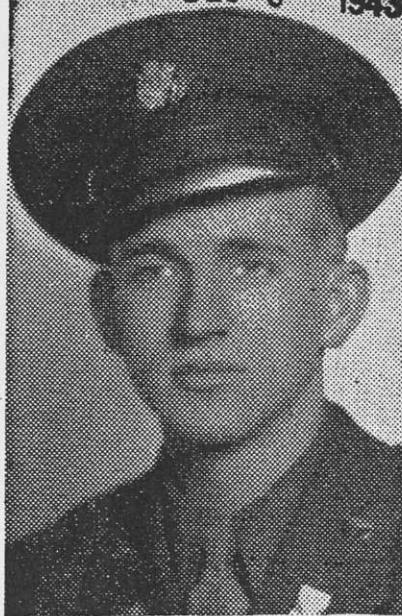


Hill Jr., Clarence

Earns Promotion DEC 8 1943

Receiving a telephone call from Aiken, S. C., Sunday evening, Mr. and Mrs. Clarence S. Hill Sr., of 625 Dellwood Street, learned that their son, Clarence S. Hill Jr., has been advanced to the rank of Corporal in the U. S. Army Air Corps. "Shelly", as he is known to his friends, graduated from Liberty High School in 1941 and prior to enlistment in November, 1942, was employed in the Order Entry Department of the Bethlehem Steel Co. and played on its softball team. Following his enlistment, he was inducted at Camp Meade, Md., and received his basic training at Miami Beach, Fla. He attended the Technical Training School in Chicago, Ill., graduating from there last June as a radio operator-mechanic, and was allocated to the Aiken Air Field, attached to the 19th Liaison Squad, where he has since been based. A member of the ground crew, his duties require considerable flying which has carried him over a majority of the Eastern States and some west of the Mississippi. He will celebrate his 21st birthday on December 16.
